The Council's priorities are aimed to support a:


- **Culture of Innovation**

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### Activities and Initiatives

*This year, the Council aims to:*

#### Culture of Innovation

- Provide new opportunities for our students to hone their leadership skills and invest resources into arts, reading, maths, languages and indigenous learning through fundraising initiatives.
- Support opportunities for hands on, experiential activities (e.g., make progress on outdoor classroom initiative, partner with Fallingbrook School Age Program on securing funds for new kinders play structure).
- Modernize the school library as a learning commons.

#### Culture of Caring

- Partner with Fallingbrook's Safe and Inclusive Committee by appointing a parent/guardian representative to help devise and implement a comprehensive action plan to educate, promote mindfulness, and curb bullying.
- Develop and implement a communication strategy to enhance communications between parents, teachers, and the broader school community. The goal is to share information and build a sense of community and inclusiveness.
- Develop effective working relationships with the school and board administration to advance equity of access, opportunity and outcomes by addressing facility maintenance and modernization; and advocating for inviting, comfortable, safe and accessible school e.g., AC/cooling, landscaping/grading, affirmative sayings on interior walls; park bench(es) in junior yard; Advocate to municipal and provincial leaders when required.
- Promote and enhance parent involvement in school activities and Council.
- Coordinate school lunch programs and socials, prioritizing the dignity and well-being of students in inclusive and caring classrooms.
